

SITE FACT SHEET

Cape Flattery Battery *Site 12*



Description: The site consists of two abandoned concrete bunkers and a gravel access road near the mouth of the Waatch River. The larger structure was a fire control observation site, and the smaller bunker was the proposed Meteorological Station. The battery reportedly included two 6-in. and two 16-in. gun emplacements, but not all of these have been identified on the ground. The U.S. Army started constructing this coastal defense system in the early 1940s but abandoned the project in 1943 before construction was complete.

Community Impacts: Abandoned structures; disturbed terrain.

Investigations and Actions to Date: Site inspections were performed by the Makah Environmental Restoration Team in October 2000 and November 2004.

Planned Activities: Confirm site conditions for No Further Action determination.
