

SITE FACT SHEET

Cape Flattery Dam *Site 24*



Description: This site consists of one concrete dam and one small reservoir formed by damming Flattery Creek. These structures are now abandoned. During late spring and summer, the dam is obscured from the road by dense vegetation. The dam is believed to have been built on Flattery Creek at the time of the construction of the Cape Flattery Battery to provide a source of water for the concrete.

Community Impacts: The dam impacts the natural hydrology of Flattery Creek.

Investigations and Actions to Date: Site inspections were performed by the Makah Environmental Restoration Team in March and April 2004.

Planned Activities: Work with Makah Fisheries to plan dam removal; remove the dam.
